- Fire House Update: Attended the update meeting on 1-11. Installation of the steel roof has resumed, contingent on the weather. Drywall is complete and painting has begun. Windows are installed. Information technology and wiring continue throughout the building.
- Market Street Update: The ribbon cutting is set for Wednesday, January 24th. Staff is working on the street light proposal for the street.
- Service Superintendent is working with Montgomery County Soil and Water on the various flooding issues throughout the City. City Council's Storm Water work session is scheduled for Tuesday, January 30th at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall.
- Assembling a Safe Routes to School Committee.
- Reviewed the proposal for repairs for the Brookville Theatre and scheduling a meeting to determine the extent of the repairs needed.
- Attended the Mayor Seagraves' Prayer Breakfast with great attendance and a wonderful message.
- Attended the Perry Township Trustee meeting with Chief Fletcher and inquired about the status of our proposed Fire/EMS contract. The Trustees have not made a decision on the contract and have changed to one meeting per month.
- RTA officials will attend Council's first meeting in February to present on the bus line changes for Brookville.
- Met with ProStratus regarding Fire House IT items.
- Attended the Mayors and Managers dinner in Vandalia with Montgomery County Engineer Paul Gruner as the guest speaker regarding the license fee increase.
- Implementing the Mobile 311 work order system.
- Received notification from OPWC the City has been awarded financial assistance in the amount of \$182,861 for the Arlington Road Water Loop Project scheduled for 2018.
