(U//FOUO) Scope: (U//FOUO) This intelligence bulletin will convey information on the overdose epidemic in Montgomery County. This information is accurate as of the issue date. The following information regarding overdose incidents comes from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office Regional Dispatch Center calls for service and incidents from the reporting jurisdictions (see page 3 for list of reporting jurisdictions).

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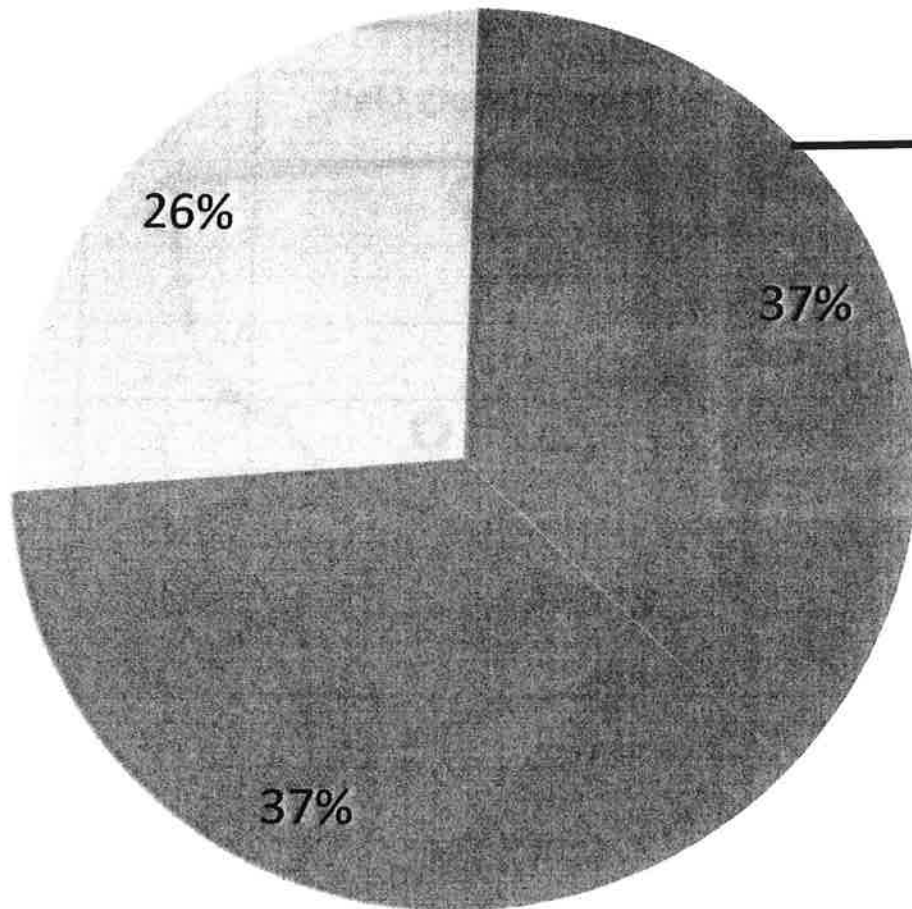
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**(U//LES) The chart below compares location of overdose calls for service during the week of 25 December 2017—31 December 2017 to home addresses of the overdose victim.**

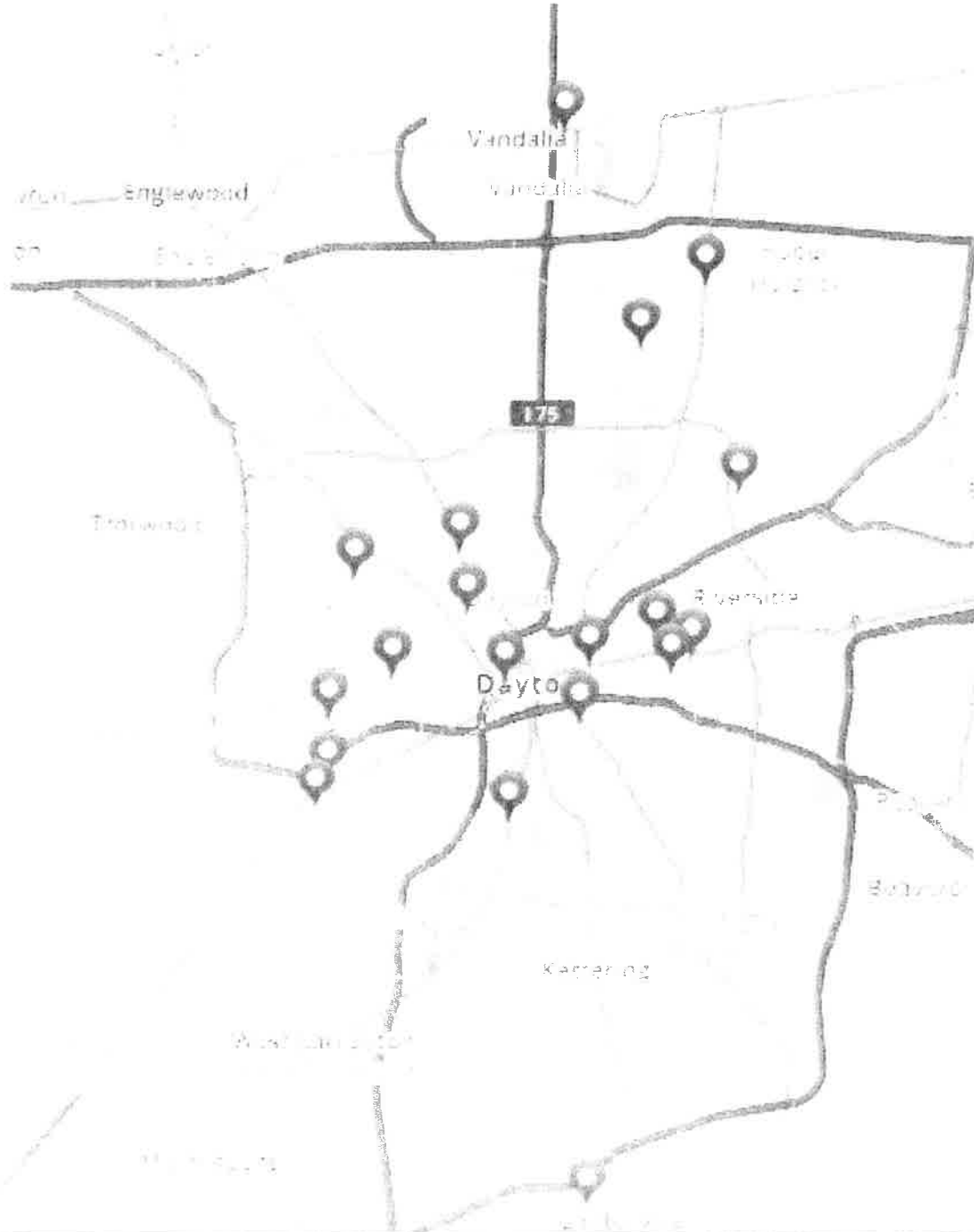

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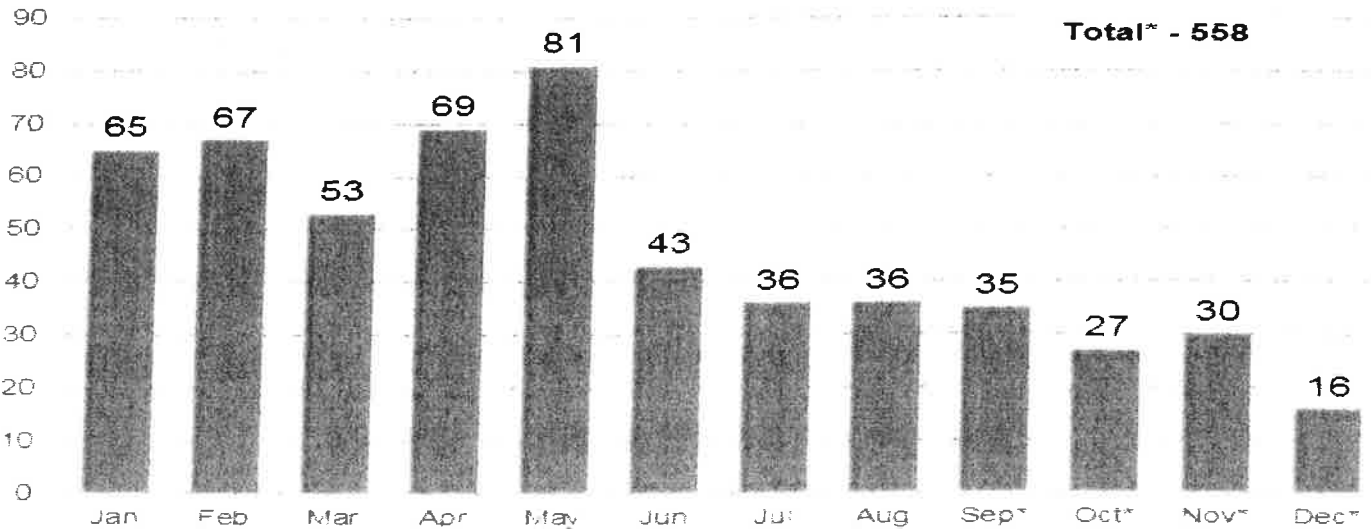
