

Service Spotlight **Winter edition 2018-2019**

Over the winter months the Service Department has accomplished several projects throughout the City.

- ❖ Repaired eight additional water main breaks
- ❖ Repaired five water service curb stops
- ❖ Demolished and removed a garage and shed from a vacant property on Vine St.
- ❖ Reconstructed a sanitary manhole on Plymouth and Arlington Rd.
- ❖ Ground and reseeded 11 tree stumps in Golden Gate, and Gateway Parks
- ❖ Removed a log jam from Wolf Creek near the Nutrition Way Water Tower
- ❖ Assisted in a fuel spill cleanup on I-70 at the Arlington Rd. exit
- ❖ Replaced a VLR shaft at the Wastewater Treatment Plant
- ❖ Started the install of the LED upgrades to the Market St lighting

The Service Department has now started the new season of mowing and lawn maintenance in the Parks system. The Philipsburg asphalt plant is scheduled to open in early May, allowing for permanent repairs of sites that were excavated over the winter.
